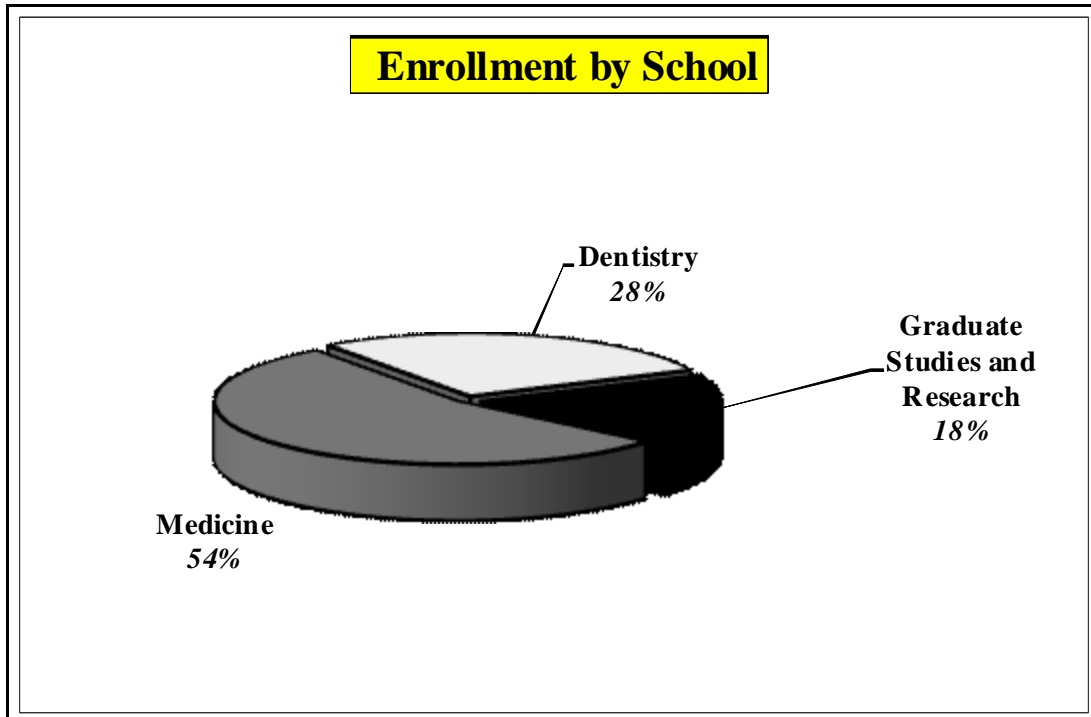

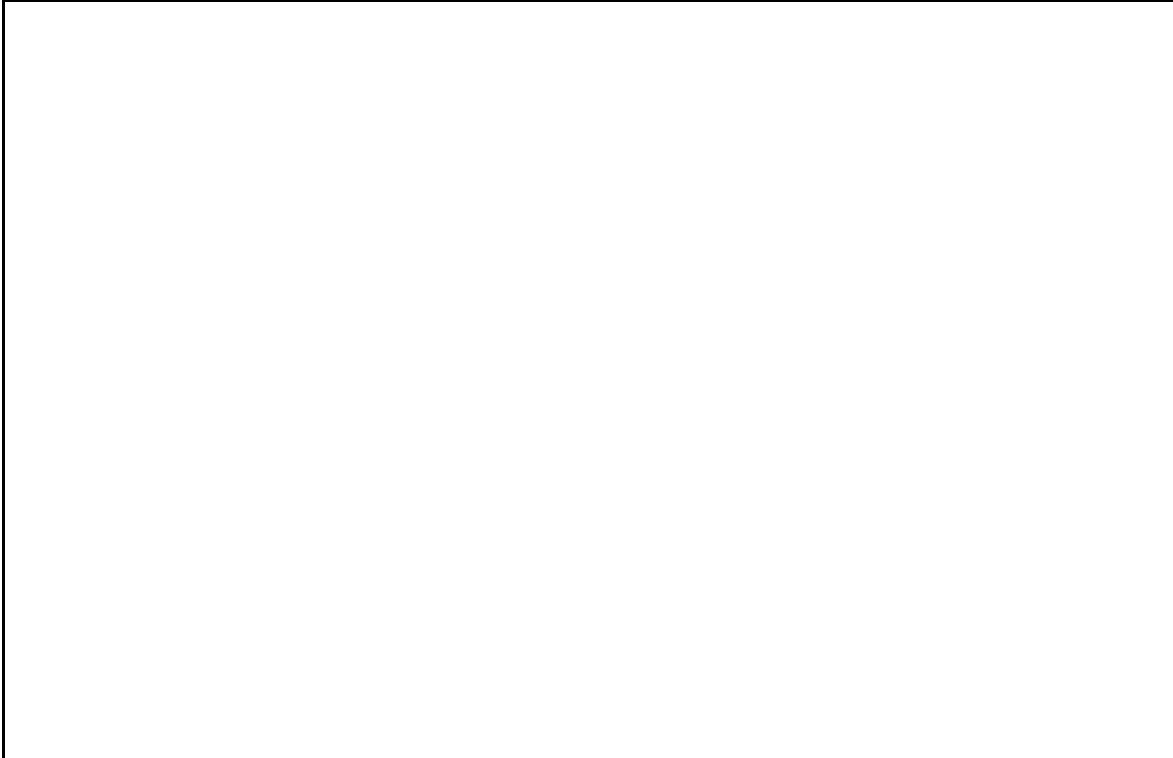

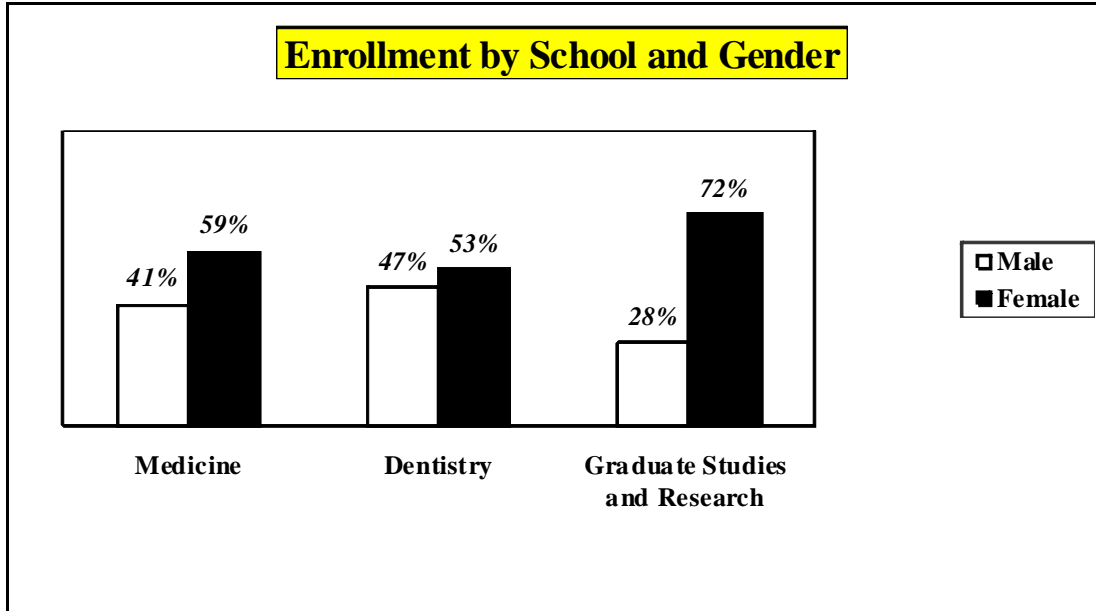

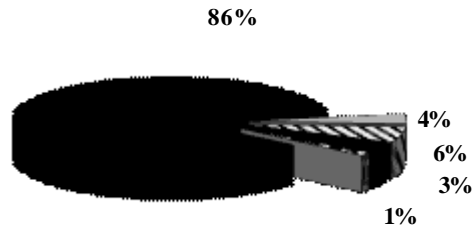

## Meharry Student Enrollment by Ethnic Origin



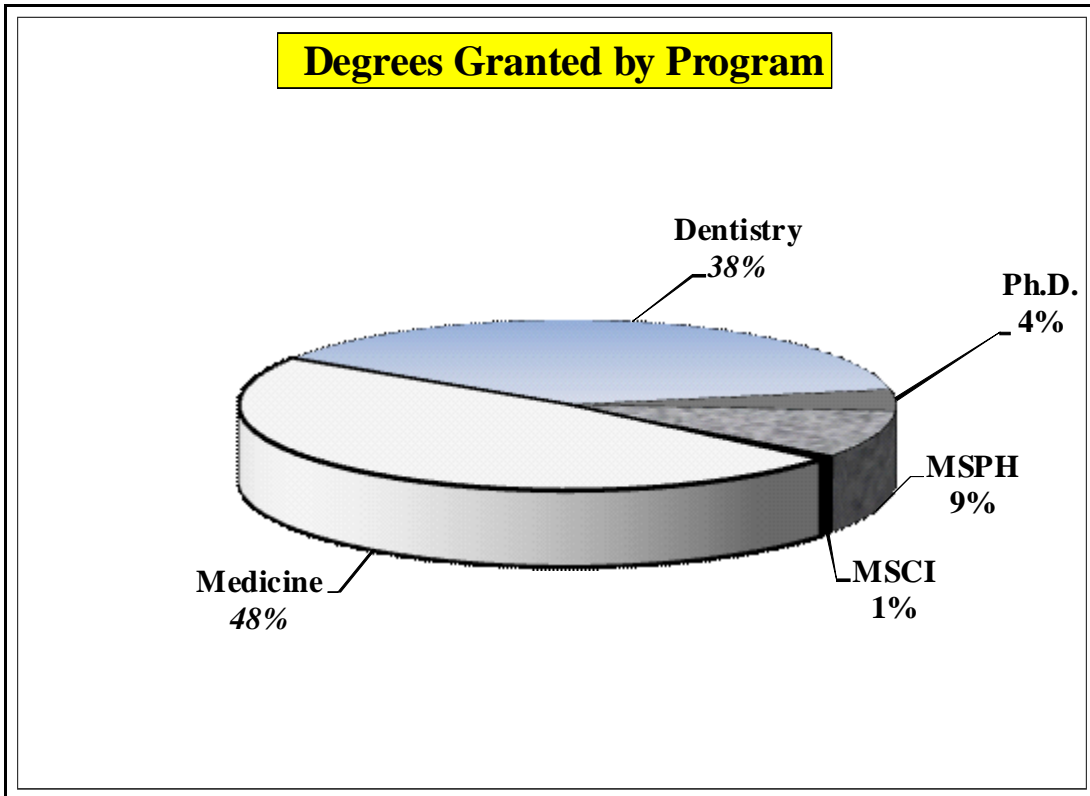

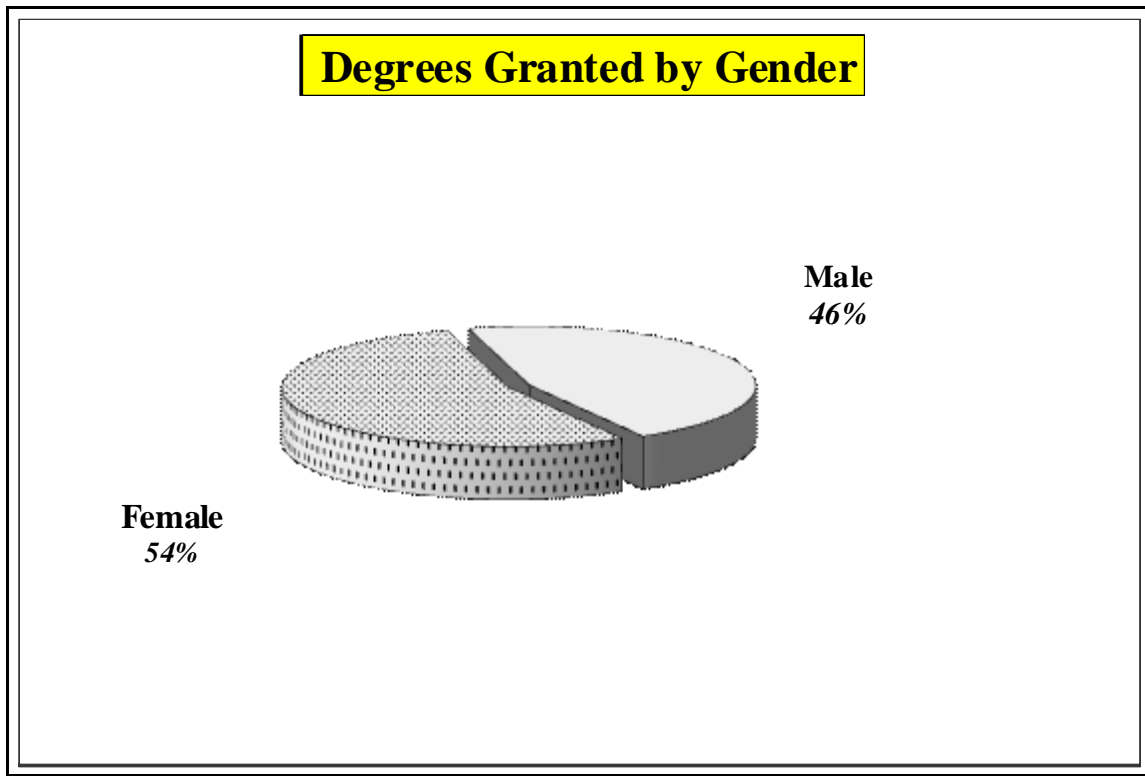

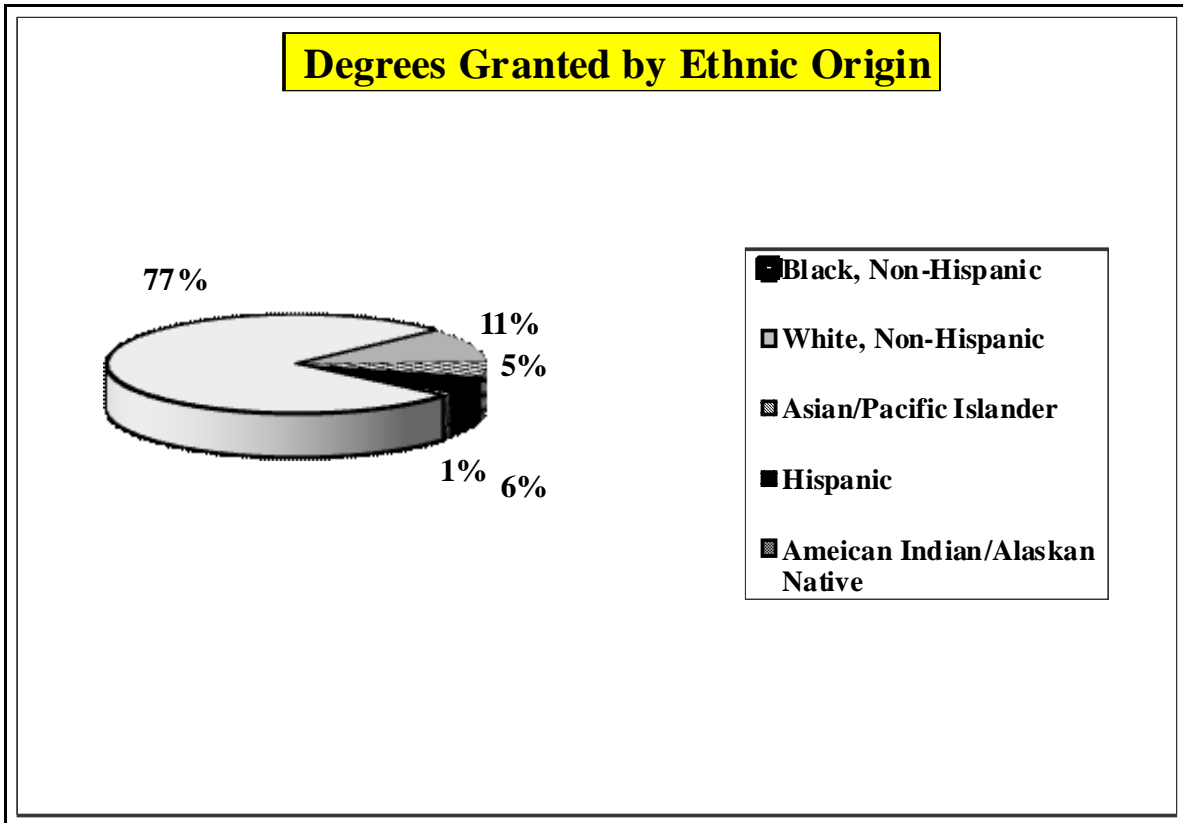
# Degrees Granted, Academic Year 2008/2009
