## About Dr. Henry W. Foster



Dr. Henry W. Foster, Jr., is Professor Emeritus, the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Meharry Medical College, Clinical Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, and is a member of the board of trustees for Charles Drew University of Medicine and Science and the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine.

From 1996-2001, he served as Senior Advisor to President Clinton on Teen Pregnancy Reduction and Youth Issues. From 1973-1990, he served as Professor and Chairman of the Department of OB/GYN at Meharry Medical College.

From 1990-1993, he was Dean of Meharry's School of Medicine and Vice President for Health Affairs. He served one year as acting President of the university, 1993-1994. Dr. Foster is a nationally recognized leader in medicine, family planning, and education. In 2004, the Henry W. Foster Obstetrics & Gynecology Educational Initiative was established to assist in supporting the newly re-established residency program at Meharry.

## About the Ob/Gyn Residency Program

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology Residency Training Program is a four year fully accredited program in general obstetrics and gynecology, geriatrics, urogynecology, maternal fetal medicine, and gynecological oncology. This program offers three positions each year for PGY 1 through PGY 4. During these four years, residents will make the transition from assisting in the care of patients to assuming total responsibility for the care of the patient in a graduated fashion, as they develop competence and proficiency in diagnostic ability, technical skills, patient management, and professionalism.
